Formative assessment will be a daily and the main tool that they use assessment as a tool for learning and not just assessment to assess, to evaluate how learning was. So I believe that self-assessment and peer assessment will be the daily routines of each student in the higher education. Regarding technologies, I think that technology in future will allow a lot of verity and less structured learning scenarios.
