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Well, already the students of today are really different from me and my generation as a student. We are really different. So it is already very hard for me to understand the students of today, what are their needs and their expectations. But trying to extrapolate what is happening, I think the first point will be the personalization of the educative experience. I mean content, I mean adaptive learning platform and customized course content in order to tailor around the needs of the students what is the content they need. Advanced digital literacy, I mean the content, the digital experience will be more and more important and sometimes they are not so addicted to this experience. Yes, they are wonderful using mobiles, that's great, but already tablets, they can have some problems. Sometimes they are not used to use a PC. So maybe we should push this point.

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It is quite weird because, for example, for my generation, it's more simple to use a PC than a tablet or even a mobile. Instead they are wonderful with mobiles, they do everything with very small screens, but they are not so smart with the PC. Usually, we are talking about a mean student. Collaboration. Obviously students in the future may have a great focus on collaboration and teamwork, more than now. So I think that they will be educated to team working, to cooperate in classroom and also thinking to interdisciplinary teams. That could be a good approach for them to find a solution for the next challenges they will have to face. Another point is that the pace of change is more and more fast, it continues to accelerate and I think that lifelong learning will be another crucial point that the students of the future will have to face.

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Finally, I think that also they live in a smaller and smaller world and being a citizen of this world will be important. Global citizenship will be an important point and I think that they will have to face some important issues like climate change, like human rights, like global health. All these topics, I am a professor of engineering so we are not particularly focused on these topics but I think that also for our students these drops could be really important because citizenship is a very important point for them to prove as a human being.
